
Lewis R Silverman, is an Associate Professor of Medicine and Oncological Sciences Director of the Myelodysplastic Syndrome and Myeloproliferative Disease Program, Mount Sinai Medical Center in New York City. His subspecialty training was in Hematology at Montefiore Medical Center, in the Albert Einstein College of Medicine and then subsequently received training in Oncology at the Mount Sinai School of Medicine, both in New York.

Dr. Silverman was awarded the National Service Research Award Fellowship from the National Cancer Institute and the Distinguished Research Award for Creative and Innovative Investigations and Inspired Mentoring of Young Biomedical Scientists from the Samuel Bronfman Department of Medicine, Mount Sinai School of Medicine.

He is a renowned investigator in the area of hematologic malignancies and has served as Principal Investigator for well over 20 national clinical trials exploring treatments for patients with the Myelodysplastic Syndrome. He served as Principal Investigator of the randomized Phase III CALGB trial of Azacitidine vs. Supportive Care which served as the basis for approval of Azacitidine by the FDA for MDS in the United States.
