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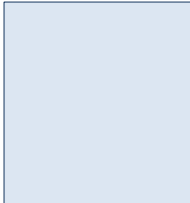


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CALL FOR ABSTRACT

Deadline for Abstract Submission: February 15, 2016

General Policies

1. The Organizing Committee of 5th TSH International Symposium (TSH-IS 2016) invites you to submit abstract(s) for poster presentations.
2. Abstracts should describe original, unpublished work and be submitted using the on-line.
3. Abstracts will not be considered unless accompanied by the completed Registration Form and Fee.
4. Abstracts must be written in English only.
5. Authors will be notified of the status of their submission, together with information on the presentation date and time by *April 15, 2016*.
6. All accepted abstracts will be published in exactly the same form and condition submitted by authors.

Abstract Content

Abstracts should include the reason(s) for the study, the method used, the findings and results, and the conclusions. Tables are not to be used unless they are essential. References are similarly discouraged but, if unavoidable, they should be incorporated into the text.

Abstract Format

- a) Abstract submissions will only be accepted on the **website www.tsh.co.th/tsh-is**
- b) Abstract submission format – please use the following instructions:
 - Complete the attached Abstract Submission Form
 - Type the abstract title in the TITLE box.
 - Type the author and co-author names, institution or organization, in the AUTHORS box. Initials will precede surname (i.e. M.A. Peters). Do not include degree and professional designations (i.e. Prof., Ph.D., M.D., etc.). Institutional affiliations should be indicated clearly.
 - The name of the presenting author(s) should appear first, and should be underlined.
 - Type the abstract in the BODY TEXT box. Maximum 400 words.
 - Begin body text without indenting. Text must be single-spaced and justified at the left margin. Indent subsequent paragraphs, and do not blank lines between them.

Presentations

1. The accepted abstracts will be assigned to present as poster presentation.
2. The authors whose abstracts are assigned to present as the poster presentation must proceed as the following:
 - a) The presenter will be requested to be available for discussion during the corresponding poster viewing session.
 - b) The usable surface of the display panels measures 180 cm. (height) x 90 cm. (width). Please use only double tape. No pushpins and glues should be use. Poster will be set up in the exhibition area.
 - c) Please use letter large enough to be read from a distance of 1.5 meters.
