



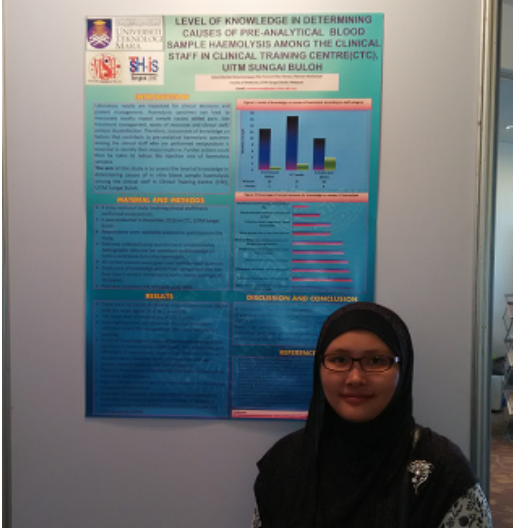
The 5th TSH International symposium “ Red Cell Disorders: From Bench to Bedside”
