**Prof. Pieter Sonneveld**  
Professor of Hematology and  
head of the Department of  
Hematology at the Erasmus

Institute Department

Pieter Sonneveld is Professor of Hematology and head of the Department of Hematology at the Erasmus MC Cancer Institute Department and Professor of Hematology at the Erasmus University of Rotterdam, the Netherlands. Professor Sonneveld leads an active research group that focuses its efforts on drug resistance mechanisms in leukemia and multiple myeloma (MM). In addition, as a founding member of HOVON – the Haemato Oncology Foundation for Adults in the Netherlands, he has been widely involved in numerous European clinical trials. Through this initiative, comprehensive guidelines and treatment standards have been established based on availability and accessibility of drugs. Ultimately this has led to improved drug access and treatment options for patients. Professor Sonneveld is the current President of the European Hematology Association(EHA) and serves on the Fellowships & Grants Review Committee; he is chair of the Scientific Working Group on Multiple Myeloma and has been a reviewer for many years. He also serves on the scientific advisory boards of the International Myeloma Foundation (IMF), the International Myeloma Working Group (IMWG), and the International Myeloma Society(IMS), and has been a member of the Editorial Board for a number of prestigious journals. In 2015 he was awarded the Robert F. Kyle Lifetime Achievement Award in recognition of his achievements in MM.

Dr Allison Tso is a Senior consultant haematologist and adjunct assistant professor at Lee Kong Chian School of Medicine. She works in Tan Tock Seng Hospital, which is Singapore's second largest acute care general hospital with over 1,500 beds. She was also the consultant haematologist at Homerton University Hospital Foundation Trust at London, UK. Dr Allison is the myeloma lead at Tan Tock Seng Hospital and one of the authors of the "Singapore Myeloma Study Group Consensus Guidelines for the Management of Patients with Multiple Myeloma".
