MSH exams

16th January – Part 2 14th July – Part 1 6th October – Part 2 This is the first year that we have 2 parts to the exam. The examination committee had put in a lot of effort to formalise Part 1 of the exams to be taken by the trainee after completing their first year of training. The Part 1 consists of 50 MCQ (Multiple Choice Questions) and 5 OSPE (Objective Structured Practical Examination) questions.

Part 2 is the exit exam which is divided into 2 sections – clinical (malignant and non-malignant) and laboratory (haemostasis/ transfusion and morphology). Candidates are eligible to sit for Part 2 after sending in their thesis and log book a month prior.


